Dear All,

Today is the last day of the summer term so I wanted to write with a few important pieces of information.

Autumn Term Arrangements

As explained in my letter on Wednesday, **all students must return in the new year and attendance is compulsory.** This is fabulous news and we can't wait to see everyone again. We have a good plan to re-induct students, and in no time at all they will be feeling confident and back into their learning routines.

We will be making some adjustments to the running of the school day to keep the environment "COVID secure" and I will write to you all just before the start of term with the full details about this. Some of this was covered in the Wednesday letter too.

Some key points to note now are:

- Year 7 & 8 will be based at KAA2, Year 9 – 13 will be based at KAA1 (this was explained in earlier letter)
- Year 10 & 11 should arrive at 8.10 each day (the early start is for key GCSE catch-up work)
- Year 7, 8, 9, 12 and 13 should arrive at 8.40 each day
- Year 7, 9, 12 and 13 will finish 15:50 each day
- Year 8, Year 10 and Year 11 will finish at 16:00 each day
- Breakfast club will operate as normal from 8 a.m. for all students who wish to attend, and will run at both KAA1 and KAA2

We will be running an extended induction programme for all students to help them return from a long period of lockdown and go over our "COVID secure" practices. The dates of the induction are as follows – **please make sure your child attends.**

Date	KAA1	KAA2
Thursday 3 rd September	Year 12 only at school	Year 7 only at school
Friday 4 th September	Year 11, Year 12, Year 13 all at school, Year 9 & 10 at home	Year 7 and Year 8 in school
Monday 7 th September	All years should return	All years return

Please note these are slightly different to the previous dates, to reflect the need for more induction.


