Summer Term Principal's Update

Dear Parents & Carers,

I'm writing with a few updates for the start of this exciting summer term.

KAA2

For the final half term of this year - Wednesday 9th June to Friday 16th July - Y11 and Y13 students will not be attending school every day, and instead come in occasionally for assessments and progression sessions. **This means we will have significantly more classroom space at KAA1, so assuming no unforeseen events, we will be able to safely bring Y7&8 students back for the last six weeks of the year.**

For this half term, students will continue to learn at KAA2. We will talk to them in the course of the coming weeks about the move back, and each student will be given the chance to spend a day here in May for orientation. This will help them get used to finding their way around the building, for example.

More detail on this to follow nearer the time, but I thought you would all want to know straight away. Miss Jordan, our Senior Vice Principal, is handling the move back, and she will host a virtual Q&A session for any parent who has queries at 6pm on Thursday 20th May (we will share link nearer the time).

Behaviour & Covid Expectations

It's more important than ever that we maintain high expectations this term, given the disruption to the curriculum earlier in the year and the end of year exams in June and July that lessons are now building towards. Students should attend every day and always be on time; stay focused and work hard in lessons; complete all homework and make sure uniform and equipment are perfect; and be courteous and polite when interacting with each other and their teachers. From a Covid perspective, we are required to continue following government guidance around mask wearing and other restrictions until further notice.

I'm very grateful for parents' continued support with these expectations. We do have a very high bar for behaviour at KAA, and students benefit a great deal from this emphasis on discipline. If your child ever makes a mistake and receives a detention, please encourage them to learn from the experience and avoid repeating the error in the future. Thank you.

Enrichment


