KAA Tutoring Programme 2021-2022

Dear Parent / Carer,

I am writing to inform you about the tutoring programme that we are offering to students in **Key Stage 4 and Key Stage 5** in advance of their examinations. Tutoring will mostly happen after school, or potentially at weekends, and will usually happen in groups of 1-3 students, so students would get very close attention. This could help them make the most progress possible in the coming months. Most importantly, this tuition will remain **free of charge to parents**, funded by the recently set up National Tutoring Programme. If your son or daughter is a Year 13 student who has a number of frees on their timetable, due to studying only 3 A Levels then it is possible we could get a tutor for them in these sessions too.

We aim to offer tutoring in as many different GCSE and A level subjects as possible, so if your son or daughter is finding there is a particular subject that is concerning them, then please do put on the form that you are interested and we will try our best to match up as many students as possible with tutors.
