Year 11 Autumn Half Term Update

Dear Y11 Parents / Carers,

We are writing to you about the expectations for Year 11 students over the half-term break.

Revision for mocks

Year 11 mocks are happening from Monday 29th November to Thursday 9th December, this means there are only 3 school weeks between students returning to school and mocks beginning. Students will receive their mock timetables in the second week back to school. Year 11 students should use the half term break to start their revision for these exams. They should create a revision timetable that includes:

- Planned days off - 2 to 4 full days with no work at all
- Half revision days - most days should contain a 2 hour morning or afternoon session
- Full revision days - 2 or 3 days of full 4 hour revision days
- Over the course of the holiday, students should aim to do about 2 hours of revision per subject

We have spoken to Year 11 students this week about how they should revise over the holiday. Specifically, students should make and follow a revision timetable to structure their revision. Students have also been shown how to make effective flashcards and given a starter pack of blank flashcards. Subject teachers have also directed students to the revision they should complete.

Post-16

As you know, deadlines are approaching for post-16 courses. For example, the KAA6 deadline is the 1st December. Students should aim to complete at least 3 applications by the beginning of December and may want to start these applications over the holiday.

Predicted grades

Students will receive their predicted grades in the first week back after half term. These will support their post-16 applications.
