GCSE & A Level Home Languages qualifications

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you regarding GCSE or A level examinations for home/second languages this year. This letter will provide you with some more information about how this will work in practice.

Students must be able to read, write, speak and understand the language fairly fluently to take GCSE, and fluently to take A level. Some additional support will be provided by the school around the exam specification and exam techniques but we are **not** able to provide actual language lessons in school. The additional support lessons will take place after school during spring 2 and summer 1.

Formal examinations will take place during the summer term but controlled assessments may take place before Easter.

We will then invite your son or daughter to **sit a mock paper** in this language **after school on Tuesday 8th February**. If your son or daughter misses this mock exam date (without legitimate reason) then unfortunately we will not be able to enter them for the exam this year.
