## House Dance Finals

Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you are well, and I am pleased to inform you that your child is soon to compete in our major house competition; House Dance! All four houses have been working hard to prepare their performances ready for the final on **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> February**. I am writing to you now to confirm the logistics for this.

On Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> February, all houses will have one lesson off timetable to rehearse. Students must come to the theatre in their school uniform at the following times:

- Period 5 – Pankhurst and Franklin
- Period 6 – Angelou and Honeyball

On Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> February the students will take part in the finale. To ensure that students are prepared for their performance they must attend school **in costume**. For most, this will be black leggings/trousers and their PE t-shirt. Students should not bring any other belongings with them other than a coat and water bottle/packed lunch if appropriate. There will be no storage space, so students should not bring anything else.

The schedule for the day will be as follows:

- Morning Reading (with usual teachers)
- Period 1 and 2 – All performers rehearse in the theatre
- Break and tutor time (with usual teachers)
- Period 3 – Performance with Year 7 audience
- Period 4 – Performance with Year 9 audience
- Lunch as usual
- Period 5 and 6 – Judged performance with Year 8 audience

We are very fortunate to be able to put on this event, with over 100 students performing. Therefore, we expect the performers to conduct themselves well and respond to all instructions appropriately. We hope everyone at home is looking forward to watching the video following the competition!
