This letter is to advise you that **Year 10 Progress Meetings** for all Year 10 students will take place on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> March from 4.30pm-7.30pm**. Parents' evenings are compulsory for parents to attend, as directed by the Department for Education, and they are a vital part of the partnership between school and home to ensure your child's success at GCSE. Your child should accompany you in full school uniform.

We are keen to minimise mixing of families and therefore we are requesting parents with children in **Pankhurst and Angelou attend between 4.30pm-6pm** and parents with students in **Honeyball and Franklin attend between 6pm-7.30pm**. At the progress meetings, you and your child will have their first opportunity to have conversations with each of their GCSE teachers. The teachers will discuss their assessment grades, behaviour and progress in lessons, and give them targets for how to improve in order to reach their potential.
