Year 6 Summer Camps Registration

Dear Parental Salutation,

We are very much looking forward to seeing students next Wednesday 6th July from 9.30am-3pm for the Year 6 Taster Day, and parents from 6pm-7pm for the Year 6 Parent Information evening.

I'm writing now to announce that throughout the summer holidays KAA will be offering a series of camps aimed at students starting with us in September. These are **all free** and will be a wonderful chance for your child to get out of the house, meet other children coming to KAA, and get used to the academy building and culture. Students will be provided with a free lunch during the summer camps. **Please note that places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.**

Year 6 Summer Camps

Art Camp - Monday 25th July to Friday 29th July, 10am-3pm (30 places)

At this camp, students will have the opportunity to express their creativity by working with a range of resources and materials across the week, culminating in the creation of various pieces of art work. Led by KAA teachers, this camp will introduce students to art at KAA in a safe, welcoming environment.

Drama, Dance and Music Summer Camp - Monday 25th July to Friday 29th July, 10am-3pm (30 places)

Performing and Creative Arts lie at the heart of the KAA curriculum and all Year 7 students are encouraged to take part in the range of activities we offer in this area. This camp will be an exciting introduction to PCA at our school and will comprise drama, dance and music sessions. Students who applied to KAA via the PCA aptitude route should attend and have already been contacted by our Director of Performing Arts, Mr Dunning. However, there will be extra places open to all new Year 7 students which you can register for now.

PE Camp - Monday 1st August to Friday 5th August, 10am-3pm (30 places)

At this camp, students will have the opportunity to take part in a variety of sports and fitness activities. Led by our teachers, students do not need a pre-existing talent or interest in sport – we can develop it in them! This camp is open to all new Year 7 students.

Transition Booster Camps - Monday 8th August to Friday 12th August, 10am-3pm (18 places)

Please note that in the first instance Transition Booster Camps in English and Maths will be offered directly to students whose primary schools have said they could particularly benefit from extra literacy or numeracy work. We will write to you with further details if your child has been recommended for these camps. However, if you would like to express an interest in your child attending the Maths or English summer camp, you can do so via the registration form.



PCA aptitude students do not need to register for the PCA camp if they have already emailed Mr Dunning to reserve their child a place.
