## GCSE Results Day – Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022

Dear Y11 Students, Parents & Carers,

GCSE results are published on **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August**. KAA will be open to students from **9am** and we are very much looking forward to celebrating with you all. I am writing now with some reminders about what you should do on results day.

### Collection of results

Students can arrive at KAA to collect their results from 9am on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August. Results will be handed out to students in person from the first floor library and staff will be available for advice and guidance throughout the day. If you would like to open your results with your parents, please collect your results from the library and meet your parents outside the main entrance as parents will not be allowed up to the library.

We strongly advise all students to collect their results in person so we can offer support for next steps. If, however, you are unable to do this, you can nominate another person to collect them for you, or instead receive them by email. Both of these are only possible if you have **explicitly requested this in advance**. To do this, please complete the form by **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> August** [linked here](#). Please note, emailed results can only be sent to **your own KAA email address**, and anyone collecting results on your behalf must bring ID with them.

### Sixth Form Enrolment

If you are an offer holder for KAA Sixth Form and meet the GCSE entry requirements, you can enrol on the day. Once you have collected your results, head to the first floor enrolment queue to complete the process straight away. External students enrolling into KAA6 will do so from 10:30am. If you would like to take up a sixth form place you must make sure you have enrolled before this point, otherwise you'll be in danger of missing out on a place.

If you have not yet applied or have done better than you had forecast, please do also speak to KAA staff for an enrolment interview. You may have to join the 6F waiting list, but staff will be able to advise you about this. If you have not quite achieved the grades you need, or are unclear about your available options, please speak to Ms Weaver, our careers advisor. She has a wealth of knowledge and will be able to support as needed. There will also be external providers with advice to support on the day.

### Laptop and book returns

If you haven't done so already, it is essential that all laptops and library/textbooks are returned before results day. Any unreturned laptops will be disabled by this point and students/parents may be liable for a charge. Please feel free to drop these off at reception on any day – labelled clearly with your full name and year group.

We look forward to seeing you all on the 25<sup>th</sup> August and hope you have a lovely summer in the meantime.
