Performing and Creative Arts Drop Down Day - Year 7

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you with the exciting news that KAA will be running a performing and creative arts drop down day for Year 7 students on **Monday 18 July**.

The purpose of the day is to develop students' passion, creativity and excellence within the performing and creative arts whilst highlighting the importance of these subjects to their education. The day will also act as a helpful tool in guiding students on whether they want to study a performing or creative arts subject at GCSE later in their school career.


The day will be based around the theme of 'Musicals' and students will have the opportunity to take part in a variety of externally and internally lead performing and creative art workshops based around this; ranging from learning how to face paint in the style of The Lion King to learning choreography from Hairspray.
