## **YII Easter Revision Sessions**

Dear Year 11 Students & Parents,

We're writing to inform of the large range of revision and intervention sessions available to Year 11 students at KAA over the Easter break. **A full timetable of sessions is attached to this email,** and teachers will be advertising these opportunities to students this week. Students are highly encouraged to make use of these sessions where relevant to them. Please note the following arrangements for attending holiday revision sessions:

- Students must arrive at the main reception five minutes before the scheduled lesson time to be registered and taken to their classroom.
- Given that the sessions are shorter than a school day and school will not be fully staffed, it is imperative
  that students are on time to the sessions, or they may not be allowed to join. If a session is full,
  those that arrive latest may be turned away.
- Whilst we expect Year 11 to have exemplary behaviour so close to their GCSEs, a reminder that normal school expectations about behaviour and mobile phones apply, though students can wear their own clothes.
- The dining hall is closed for the Easter break, so students should bring in a packed lunch if attending a full day session or multiple sessions across one day. Students will be signed out of the building at lunch and asked to return for PM sessions they will not be able to remain on site during any lunch breaks.
