



## Paying respects at the Grenfell Tower site for the 6<sup>th</sup> anniversary

The Grenfell Tower site will be open to local residents who would like to pay their respects. You will be able to come into the site, if you wish to, on:

- Sunday 11 June from 12pm to 5pm
- Monday 12 June from 1pm to 8pm

Bereaved families and survivors will also be able to pay their respects on these days.

As the site is prepared for these visits, residents may notice some additional activity on and around the site at this time.
