Y9 End of Year Exams

Dear Parent / Carer,

As we are sure you are aware, Year 9 students will be sitting their End of Year Examinations from **Monday 26**th **June** to **Friday 30**th **June**. This is a great opportunity for your child to demonstrate what they have learnt throughout their first three years at KAA in advance of their upcoming end of year reports and will give us a good indication of their progress as they commence their GCSE courses.

This means that your child's normal timetable will be replaced with an examination timetable, which they will be issued with this week. For your reference, a copy is attached to this letter. Information on our assessment policy can be found at https://kaa.org.uk/teaching-learning/assessment/.

Please note that all assessments are <u>written</u> assessments so students should come to school in their normal school uniform every day, not their PE kit. Students will sit these in the sports hall in most cases, and will be invigilated formally to give students an effective preparation for their GCSE examinations in two years time.

Form tutors will be explaining to students how the exam week will run, in detail, including behaviour expectations. It is important to note that behaviour expectations in examinations are extremely high and any disruption to the assessments will be treated as very serious incidents.

We are conscious that Eid ul-Adha may fall this year on Wednesday 28th June. We have carefully considered which exams to put on this day. We do encourage students to come in and take these end of year exams if possible, but if you do choose for them to take the day off we will ensure they receive an end of year grade for their maths and science exams, using their other exam papers or if there is time, catching up with the exams at a later date.

We cannot guarantee this with art as it is their only exam in that subject, so if students fail to sit this they will receive an X (absent mark) in their report in that subject.

Thank you in advance for your support for your students in the coming exam week and I look forward to writing to you in July with your child's end of year report.
