Competition Day - Thursday 19th October:

- Students must arrive in school wearing their allocated 'costume' / outfit which will have been clearly explained to them by their Head of House
- All students must go to the dance studio at 08:30 at the start of Morning Reading
- A small number of students will be allowed to get changed in school during Morning Reading so that they are ready for rehearsals to start at 09:00 prompt.
- We kindly ask that students **do not bring their school bag** with them, unless essential, as these are difficult to store throughout the day - students are responsible for all of their belongings throughout the day
- Students attend **Form Time AS NORMAL**
- The competition starts period 3, is repeated during period 4, and judges visit KAA to watch the competition one final time during periods 5 & 6 to award the relevant house points!
- Students will attend the small remainder of period 6 and leave school at the normal time at the end of the day unless they have an enrichment
