You have completed your Component 1 performance and only have one piece of coursework left. Your main focus must now be on Component Three. Your written exam is on the **9th May**. Your scripted exam will be in early March and we will prepare for this after Mocks.

You have two weeks to maximise your readiness for Mocks. Over half term you must complete these three steps:

Component Three Section B- Live Theatre Question

One question out of a choice of two on **The Ocean at the End of the Lane**

We watched this performance on Wednesday 11th October and have started work on this in lessons

October Half term holiday work (Everyone must complete by our first lesson (Monday 6th November)

1. Answer the 15 Mark question "Analyse and explain how **set and props** were used in two key scenes to communicate meaning to the audience" refer to the production style and your response as an audience member- use support on classroom for how to structure this

October Half Term holiday extension work (If you are aiming for a 7/8/9 you should complete this work)

1. Choose 4 key characters. Make notes on the costume they were wearing, colour, fabric and what this communicates to the audience

Component Three Section A- Noughts and Crosses

In the December mocks you will have a full paper. Section A is worth 45 marks.

October Half Term Holiday work (Everyone must complete by our first lesson (Monday 6th November)

1. Use the Noughts and Crosses revision guide (on classroom) to create five flashcards or two A4 mind maps on a choice of the following topics- Noughts and Crosses plot and context, character relationships, rehearsal techniques, staging types, set design including lighting/sound and mood and atmosphere
2. Answer the 15 Mark question "Explain how an actor playing the role of Callum on pages 77-78 , could communicate his character to the audience" In your answer refer to character motivation, voice, movement and interaction.

October Half Term extension work (If you are aiming for a 7/8/9 you should complete this work)

1. Draw a set design in Traverse for p52-53 – annotate justifying your decision
2. Draw a set design for In the Round for p40-42 - annotate justifying your decisions
