### 1 Consolidation of this term

This half term you have covered Theme 2, and you will soon on Theme 3 (how quickly this half term has gone !). You need to ensure you have revised and understood the topics well. I can't emphasise this enough, but CHECK GOOGLE CLASSROOM, THERE IS LOADS ON THERE.

How to do this:

- Input all key vocab from lessons onto flashcards (either physical or on an app) and revise them.
- Ensure all Theme 2 answers have been written up in your Speaking/Writing booklets.
- Revise on LanguageNut, there are activities there for you to choose from. These are not homework tasks, but ones generally available.

### 2 General revision

- Complete ALL questions in your Speaking/Writing booklet for Themes 1 and 2, making sure each answer contains a complex structure.
- ALL questions in the Speaking/Writing booklet are available in audio form on Google Classroom. This means you can hear the questions out loud and pause after each one to answer. It will feel like a real speaking exam.
