YII Spring Mock Exams

Dear YII Parents / Carers,

Following on from our last email before half term, I am writing to inform you about the upcoming Year II Mocks taking place from **Monday 26th February to Friday 8th March**. A full timetable is attached to this email.

During the mock period there will be some changes to the school day. Students are expected to arrive every day at the usual time – between 8:00am and 8:30am. Their finish time will depend on the length of their afternoon exam. There are no normal Year I I lessons taking place during the two-week mock period. Instead, students will have mock exams or study sessions. If a student does not have an exam, they will study in a classroom supervised by a teacher – but they will be expected to revise independently throughout the study session. If students don't have an afternoon exam, they will be registered by their usual classroom teacher at 2pm and then sent home to revise (behaviour dependent). A reminder that students are expected in everyday across the two-week mock exam period, including any day(s) where they do not have an exam.

We are keen to make this mock exam experience as much like the real GCSE weeks as possible. Therefore, if a student misses an exam for an unauthorised reason, they may receive a U grade for that paper. If you are aware of any unavoidable medical (or other) appointments, please let us know immediately so we can reschedule any exams in advance, during the "catch up" exam periods.

Any detentions for Year II will accumulate and be sat on Fridays each week during this time so that students are able to concentrate on their revision during the school week. Given how hard students have been working and how important this period is, however, we expect very few detentions. Students should be aware that the exams will be externally invigilated so **formal exam behaviour** and conduct will be expected. Failure to meet these expectations (talking/turning around in exams, having a smart watch or phone on their person, etc.) will be sanctioned severely. As per the last set of mocks, students are expected to attend their mock exams in **full school uniform**.

Students should now be revising at home in preparation for these mock exams and the real GCSEs to follow. Creating a revision timetable will really help them do this in an organised way. We have issued each student with a blank revision timetable and advised them on how to go about this. Please go through these revision timetables with them so you know how they are preparing. Students will also be given a personal copy of their exam timetable this week. This shows when each of their exams are and how long they will last. Students must take care of these and bring them into school every day during the mock period.

Students will receive their results on the Spring Term reports which will be emailed to parents/carers during the first week after the Easter holidays. There is also a **Year II 'Crunch Time'** parent's evening taking place that week on **Thursday 18th April at 6.00pm.** Please add this date to your diary now if you have not already done so.

Lastly, we know the period of mock exams and lead up to the formal examinations in the summer can be a pressured and anxious time for many students. Please be assured that we are preparing students for these exams carefully and always have their wellbeing at the heart of everything we do.
