**What do you need to do during the term break to consolidate this term and progress further? Follow these three steps:**

### **1** Consolidation of this term

- This half term you have covered theme 3 so you need to ensure you have revised and understood this as well as you possibly could have.
- How to do this: read through all of your work and worksheets in your book(s), ensure you have revised your speaking and writing questions in your booklet on this topic, use Seneca and Kerboodle to practise.

### **2** General revision

- Complete ALL questions in your speaking booklet, making sure each answer contains complex structures.
- Learn these answers off by heart. Ask someone at home or a friend to test you on your speaking questions

- **This includes but is not limited to: comparatives and superlatives** "Ich finde Memrise nützlicher als Seneca/ Snapchat ist am besten", **relative clauses** «Ich habe einen Bruder, der Mohamed heisst », **conditional tense** « ich würde gern in der Karibik wohnen », **infinitive constructions** « ich esse viel Gemüse, um gesund zu bleiben »
